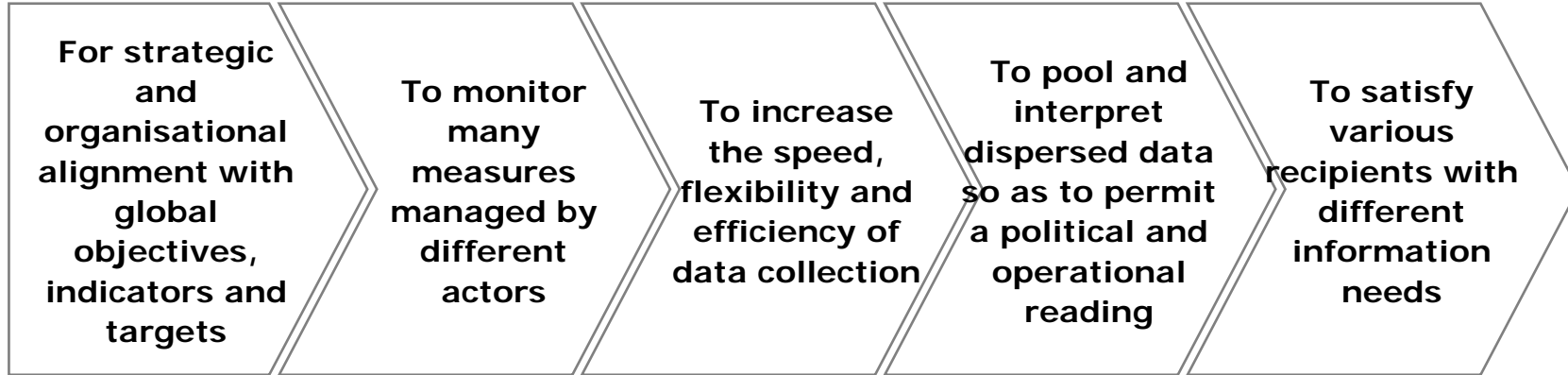

**Strategic
Alignment**



- To guarantee the measures' alignment with the strategic objectives of the Technological Plan
- To analyse the evolution of impact indicators in the light of the measures that contributed to them
- To define the right monitoring level for each measure

**Operational
Coordination**



- To assure constant collection of information on each measure
- To further articulation between all entities involved in implementing each measure

**Monitoring of
implementation**



- To automatise the compiling and presentation of information on the implementation of the various measures
- To permit on-going assessment of how measures are being implemented and their results

- To allow the writing of a regular report based on concrete and reliable data and fluid, on-going and transparent communication

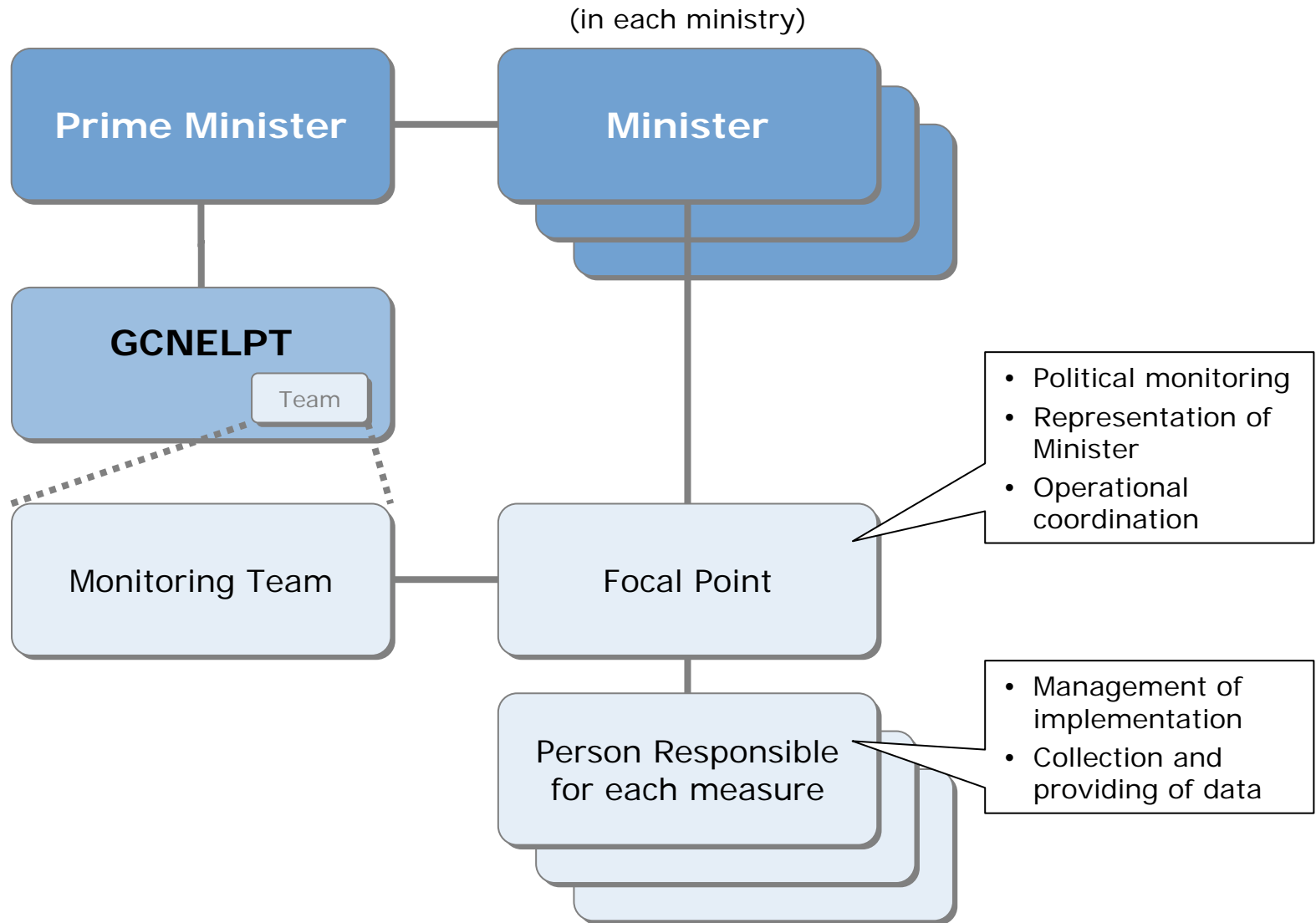
